- When personal information is available from a public source;
- When we need the advice of a lawyer;
- For the purposes of collecting debt or protecting against fraud;

Other legally established reasons.

We will not sell your personal information to other parties unless consent has been provided or implied. We keep your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfill the stated purpose or for legal or business purposes. We will make reasonable efforts to keep your personal information accurate and complete. You can request a correction to your personal information to ensure its accuracy and completeness. A request must be made in writing and provide sufficient detail to identify your personal information and the correction sought. We are committed to ensuring the security of your personal information and we reserve the right to use passwords, encryption, firewalls, restricted employee access or other methods, at our discretion, to ensure their security. We will use appropriate security measures when destroying your personal information such as shredding documents or deleting information stored electronically, at our discretion.

Data gathering
